- STAFF RELATIONSHIPS WITH PARTICIPANTS ARE POSITIVE, SUPPORTIVE, NURTURING AND CONSISTENT
- STRONG SUPERVISION
- PROGRAM SPACE AND EQUIPMENT FIT THE NEEDS OF PARTICIPANTS, STAFF AND THE CURRICULUM
