- III. A. Commissioner Coffey introduced two members of the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation, Chris C. VanMarren and Dennis Wischman. They presented information and photos in re opening the Alcove Reservoir to public fishing.
- B. Christopher Quirk, Chief Fiscal Officer, presented a Combined Statements of Cash Flows and other Oombined Financial Information of the Albany Water Board and Albany Municipal Authority for the one month period ended October 31, 2014
