**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION FOR A STATE GRANT-IN-AID FOR A MUNICIPAL WASTE REDUCTION AND/OR RECYCLING PROJECT AND SIGNING OF THE ASSOCIATED STATE CONTRACT, UNDER THE APPROPRIATE LAWS OF NEW YORK STATE**

**WHEREAS**, the State of New York provides financial aid for municipal waste reduction and municipal recycling projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Albany herein called the MUNICIPALITY, has examined and duly considered the applicable laws of the State of New York and the MUNICIPALITY deems it to be in the public interest and benefit to file an application under these laws; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary that a Contract by and between THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, herein called the STATE, and the MUNICIPALITY be executed for such STATE Aid;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Common Council:

1. That the filing of an application in the form required by the State of New York in conformity with the applicable laws of the State of New York including all understanding and assurances contained in said application is hereby authorized
2. That Nicholas J. D'Antonio, Commissioner of the Department of General Services (or his designee) is directed and authorized as the official representative of the MUNICIPALITY to act in connection with the application and to provide such additional information as may be required and to sign the resulting contract if said application is approved by the STATE.
3. That the MUNICIPALITY agrees that it will fund its portion of the cost of said Municipal Waste Reduction and/or Recycling Project.
4. That the MUNICIPALITY or MUNICIPALITIES set forth their respective responsibilities by attached joint resolution relative to a joint Municipal Waste Reduction and/or Recycling Project.
5. That this resolution shall take effect immediately.

**TITLE**

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION FOR A STATE GRANT-IN-AID FOR A MUNICIPAL WASTE REDUCTION AND/OR RECYCLING PROJECT AND SIGNING OF THE ASSOCIATED STATE CONTRACT, UNDER THE APPROPRIATE LAWS OF NEW YORK STATE

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**GENERAL PURPOSE OF LEGISLATION**

To authorize the Commissioner of DGS to file an application with State DEC to seek up 50% reimbursement for the 2006 purchases of a tub grinder, recycled material screener and the John Deere loader used in the City's recycling program. DGS is also seeking reimbursement for the household recycling bins that the City purchased in 2006 and 2007. If the grant is approved, the State may reimburse the City of Albany up to \$331,803.

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**NECESSITY FOR LEGISLATION AND ANY CHANGE TO EXISTING LAW**

Passage is necessary so that the application can be submitted to the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation on or before January 31, 2012.
