

2021 Second Quarter Arrests and Diversions

September 2, 2021

The following document presents an analysis of arrests and LEAD diversions in April, May, and June of 2021; this data is extracted from the Albany Police Department Record Management System and LEAD documentation.

Table 1 depicts arrests, diversions, and a diversion rate by race. Table 1A shows diversions over time by race.

*Note: The diversion rate is calculated by dividing diversions by combined arrests and diversions. See Table 4 for figures on the City of Albany's 2020 population by race/ethnicity.

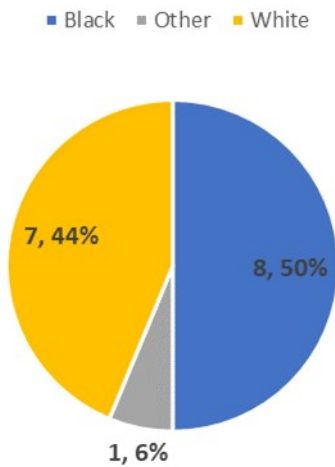

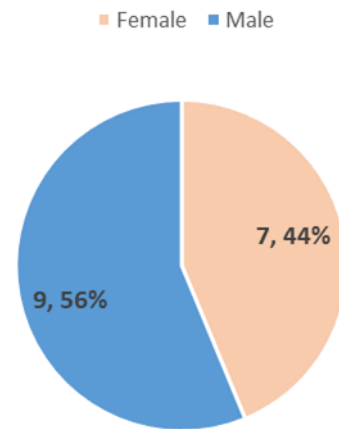

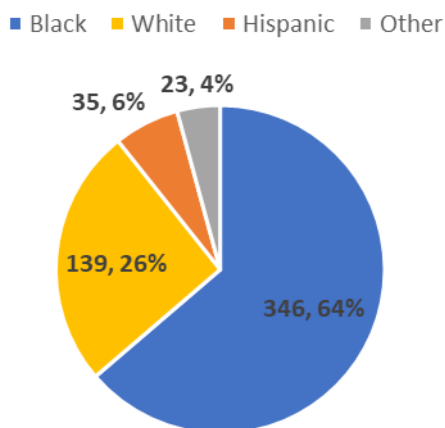
2A LEAD DIVERSIONS BY RACE

2B ARRESTS BY GENDER

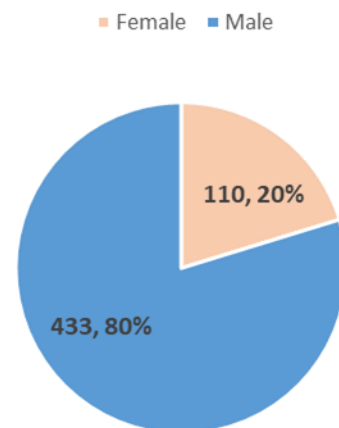


Table 3A shows the total number of LEAD diversions, average age, made by the Albany Police Department in the second quarter of 2021. Table 3B shows the total number of arrests, average age, excluding diversions made by the Albany Police Department during the aforementioned time frame.

Table 3C shows the racial/ethnic breakdown by eligibility status of arrested individuals. The following tables, 3D and 3E, show the gender by percentage for those arrested individuals and average age. Eligibility status of participation in LEAD depends on arrest charge.

Note: The officers’ selection of “non-diversion reason” may not statistically align with the above tables due to there being multiple reasons for non-diversion. This information should be used for broad interpretation purposes only.
