

Albany Water Board Public Notice for Rate Increase

The Albany Water Board manages the water supply at our reservoirs, processes the water at our treatment plant, and reliably delivers water through nearly 400 miles of distribution system piping. We also maintain nearly 900 miles of pipeline that safely carry away wastewater and stormwater. Much of Albany's water and sewer infrastructure is over 100 years old. Repairs and upgrades are necessary to guarantee the delivery of clean water and the removal of wastewater and stormwater.

Your water and sewer bill pays for these improvements, as well as daily operations and maintenance.

Albany Water Board is proposing a 2.5% increase to water and sewer rates, effective February 1, 2022. This change would increase the average residential bill (currently \$571.20/yr.) by approximately \$14 per year, and the minimum bill (currently \$226.68) by \$5.67 per year.
