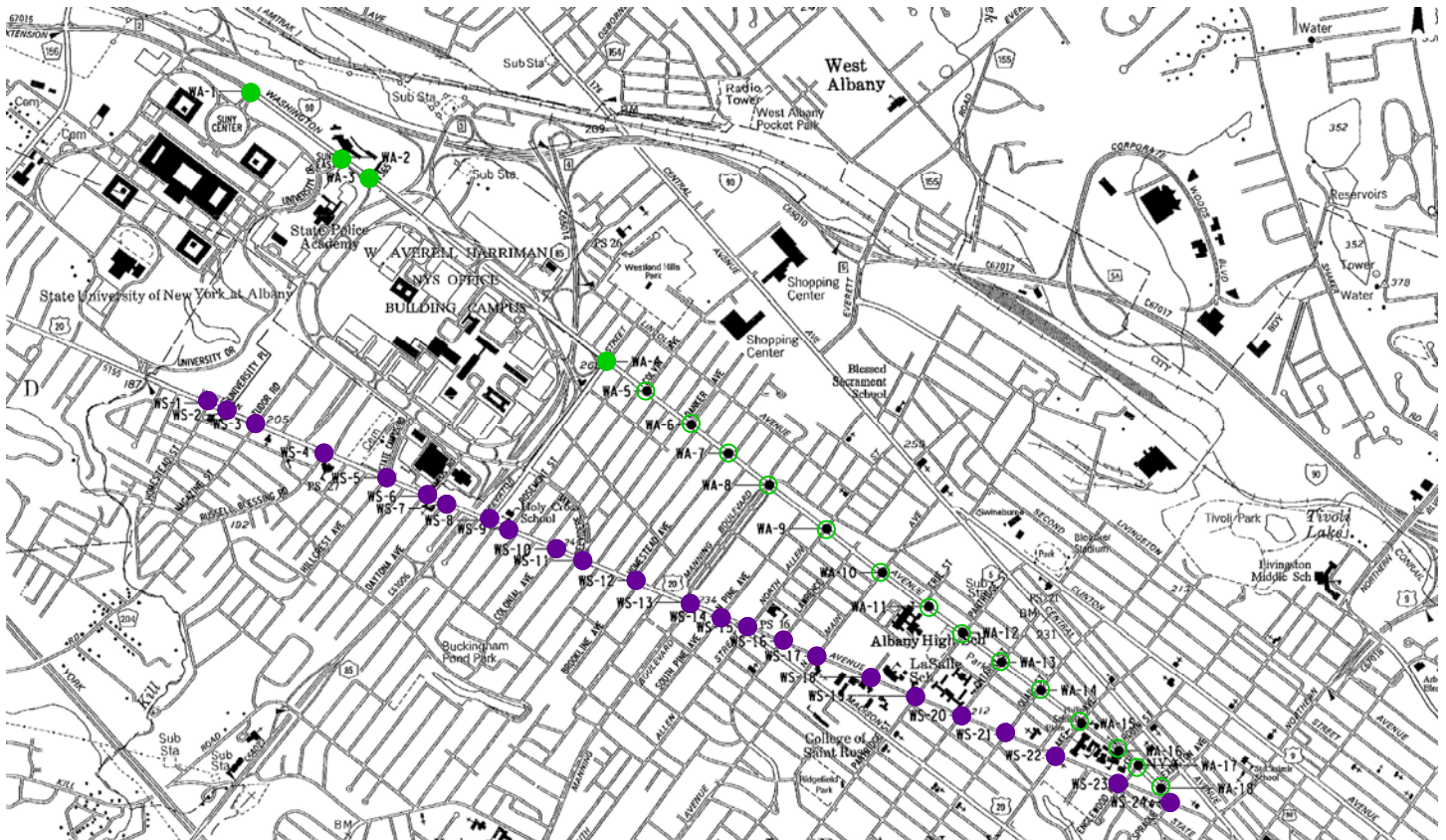


WASHINGTON AND WESTERN AVENUES TRAFFIC SIGNAL REHABILITATION PROJECT

This project involves the rehabilitation of 28 traffic signals in the City of Albany, including 24 intersections along Western Avenue from Homestead Street to the Sprague Place/Washington Avenue intersection, and four (4) intersections along Washington Avenue from the Collins Circle/SUNY Center intersection to Brevator Street. Fourteen (14) additional signals may be added along Washington Avenue if funding becomes available.
